Workshop Description:

Conflict happens! In this workshop, participants will explore healthy conflict resolution models, and will practice strategies from each model to apply conflict resolution at school and at home.

Lesson Outline:

- 1. Introduction
- 2. Intent-Action-Effect: Participants will examine this conflict resolution model and will practice concepts in an interactive team-building game.
- 3. Positions and Interests: Participants will examine this conflict resolution model and will brainstorm how to apply the model with a small group.
- 4. Debrief and conclusion: Participants will reflect on the challenges and key learnings from this workshop through an activity and discussion.
