SHSM WORKSHOPS

- **Conflict Resolution:** Participants will practice tools to build their conflict resolution toolkit to navigate conflict with family, friends, and in the workplace.
- **Communication Skills:** Participants will build constructive communication tools to confidently collaborate at school and in the workplace.
- **Leadership:** Participants will practice tools to build their leadership toolkit to navigate challenges they may face at school and in the workplace.
- Ethical Considerations: Participants will practice tools to analyse situations and make decisions ethically in family, social and workplace settings.

CONFLICT RESOLUTION WORKSHOPS

- **Conflict Resolution for Leaders:** Participants will explore strategies to build connection, communicate transparently and make decisions collaboratively.
- **Conflict Resolution for Health Classes:** Participants will explore strategies for healthy communication during conflict situations in their close relationships. This workshop aligns with Ontario Health curriculum standards.

PEACEMAKING & JUSTICE WORKSHOPS

- **Peace Innovation:** Participants will build tools to address challenging and systemic social issues and injustices.
- **Building Inclusive Community:** Participants will explore their own biases and how to inclusively problem-solve.
