WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

Participants will:



Build sustainability in their homes and communities



Bring awareness to environmental impact



Advocate for human rights

Activity Description:

- In this team trading game, groups will need to strategize and collect components to build a house, a garden, and a road for their community. Throughout various rounds, teams will trade and use actions to achieve their goal, but how will it impact other teams and natural resources?

Workshop Outline:

1. Introduction
2. Activity: Participants will work in teams to strategically gain resources to build what they need to win the game.
3. Debrief and conclusion: Participants will reflect on the effect of their environmental actions on their own sustainability and other's well-being. Participants will discuss their own environmental actions and impacts in everyday life.

TIME

- 60 minutes
